The **Launch Pad Facilitator (LPF)** is a new, part-time opportunity, (ten hours per week) focused on facilitating early learning and language experiences at Launch Pad locations in **Troup County, Georgia**.

A central focus of the LPF's work will be creating a safe, nurturing, and engaging learning environment at the **Launch Pads (LPs)**—weekly, two-hour purposeful play sessions designed for **parents/caregivers and their children ages 0-5**. These sessions will be hosted in key locations throughout **LaGrange, Hogansville, and West Point**.

Key Launch Pad Responsibilities:

- Plan and implement age-appropriate lessons and activities that align with early learning standards
- Foster curiosity, creativity, and a love for learning through structured play and exploration
- Promote positive social interactions and guide children in developing self-regulation skills
- Communicate regularly with families about child progress and developmental milestones
- Maintain a safe, organized, and supportive environment

 - Minimum of three years of experience working with young children in early childhood education
 - Demonstrated experience collaborating effectively with others
 - Strong communication, patience, and relationship-building skills
 - Knowledge of early childhood development and best practices in preschool instruction

- 4 Associate Degree, Bachelors Degree or equivalent work experience in an Early Learning Center.
